


# Summer Reading 2014

### Residents and Property Owners of Boone:

Spring is upon us which, along with the good weather, brings green grass and lots of growth. The city of Boone is required by ordinance to maintain properties that do not cut grass, weeds and volunteer trees. As part of our process, the city has advertised and received bid proposals for this grass mowing. These bids for the 2014 mowing season are \$50 per lot. This coupled with the required \$50 civil penalty and \$5 administrative fee make the charges for neglected properties a minimum of \$105.

Residents and property owners are encouraged to take notice of these property maintenance requirements. The city of Boone appreciates your cooperation in keeping properties in compliance with applicable ordinances to avoid these charges. # City Wide Clean-Up

Our annual City Wide Clean-Up event is intended to assist property owners by hauling away items not normally placed at the curb for regular weekly garbage pickup (i.e. TVs, box springs, furniture). We want to foster a clean community. So let your friends and neighbors know about the event. This event is for residential use only.

**IMPORTANT DATES**

NORTH of MAMIE  
Have all items on curb on **Sunday June 1st** . Public Works will pick up items from June 2nd thru the 6th.

SOUTH of MAMIE  
Have all items on curb on **Sunday June 8th**. Public Works staff will pick up items from June 9th thru the 13th.

**This year again:** You can drop off your appliance for FREE on the **14th of June** or you may choose to pay a fee and schedule a time for Public Works to pick up your appliances.

APPLIANCE & TIRE PICK UP (see restrictions below)  
Pick up dates: June 12th and 13th. **Please call by May 30th by 3:00 p.m.** to schedule your pick-up 432-4211 ext 142.

APPLIANCE DROP OFF  
**June 14th 8:00 a.m. to Noon. Drop off appliances at the Boone City Shed at 1410 8th Street. There will be a charge for TV's, Monitors, and gas grill propane tanks. See front page of sheet for details.**

ALL ITEMS MUST BE PLACED according to the dates noted. Items placed at the curb after the mentioned dates will NOT be picked up.

## Appliance and Tire Pick-up

Appliances must be empty. Refrigerators and freezers must have doors removed. If doors are not removed your appliance will not be picked up and all fees are non-refundable.

**PAYMENTS AND FEES**  
For **APPLIANCE and TIRE pick-up**

Payment must be made prior to pickup and can be made at the Boone City Parks & Public Works Department (City Hall, 923 8th St.) For more information call 432-4211 ext. 142

**Fees**  
\$25 per appliance – gas water heaters, washers, dryers, empty refrigerators and freezers, stoves, dishwashers, furnaces, dehumidifiers, air conditioners, microwaves.

**Fees for Tires**  
\$2 for each motorcycle, car or light truck tires w/out rim  
\$4 on the rim  
\$3 for each pick-up truck tire w/out rim  
\$8 on the rim  
\$9 for each semi or dump truck tire w/out rim  
\$18 on the rim  
\$20 for each small farm machinery tire  
\$30 for each medium farm machinery tire  
\$40 for each large farm machinery tire  
Bicycle tires – no charge
