



### Shop With A Cop

December 8th "Shop with a Cop" will be in its 15th year. The Downtown streets of Boone will be filled with children kindergarten thru sixth grades. They will shop with officers and volunteers for basic necessities and Christmas gifts for their families. Each child will have \$100 to spend. These children are nominated by school teachers, administrators and social workers. Nomination forms are available at the police department, in Boone Schools and at the former Iowa Department of Human Services building on West Mamie Eisenhower Ave. Forms must be submitted to "Shop With A Cop" by Thanksgiving. Criteria for being chosen are that the children are in the Boone Community School District and grades K-6th. Donations are always welcome and can be dropped off in piggy banks located in stores throughout the city or deposited in the "Shop With A Cop" account at either VisionBank location in Boone.
