Arts Commission Proceedings

May 26, 2021

The Arts Commission met on May 26, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. in the City Hall, second floor, Conference Room. The following members were present: Stecker, Williamson, Hutchcroft, Rasmussen, and Byrd. Absent: Davis, Jordan.

Rasmussen moved; Williamson seconded to approve the agenda as presented. Ayes: all those in attendance. Nays: none.

Hutchcroft stated she has had some conversations with Ondrea Elmquist about finances; the City is months away from taking credit cards. The Arts Commission has a budget of \$5,000.00 in a separate account. The Commission discussed if a spreadsheet could be created to collect data from people who join a membership.

The Commission discussed their setup schedule for the Arts in the Park Event and the Arts Commission's booth on May 30, 2021.

The Commission planned for the Farmer's Market and 1st Thursday's events on June 3, 2021. Stecker has made a poster/flyer as there is a lot of information to get to the community regarding free food, music, the farmers market, and the green space dedication. The Boone County Chamber of Commerce has a liquor license for the summer and bracelets to show that people have been ID'd. It was noted that local restaurants have shown interest but many have staffing issues and cannot attend. Hutchcroft will be at the Arts Booth at 5:00 p.m. on the southeast corner.

The Commission discussed judging a photo contest at Pufferbilly Days.

The next meeting will be June 23, 2021 at 12:00 p.m. at the Green Space.

In other business, Williamson received a \$100.00 donation, and suggested an idea about interactive music equipment. The Commission discussed the timeframe of memberships; should they run January to December or from the month started for one (1) year. Stecker stated that Kathi Stirling contacted her about kid's classes.
