- Joyful Noise Children's Choir: McKnight updated Board on Joyful Noise Children's Choir. McKnight stated that participation and sign up has been slow starting. A consensus was reached to table that activity for this event, but the Arts Council will still promote the Choir and have sign up available at the Arts Council Table at the event.
- Art Attack. Blakely introduced the idea of capturing moments with people who are artful or being artistic. A gold coin will be given for \$1.00 off at the vendors. Maximum amount to spend will be \$25.00.
