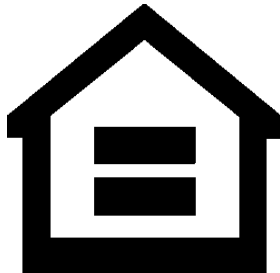

Blockbusting is also illegal

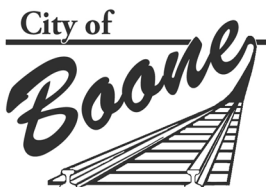

### Please be aware of the following City Code in regards to Municipal Infractions.....

Chapter 4.03 (2) C.) Any violation of the restrictions prohibiting blowing grass, leaves or snow into the street "open burning", curfew as defined in Chapter 46, or placing signs in the public right-of-way shall carry the following penalties:

- (1) Second offense – \$75.00 fine
- (2) Third offense – \$300.00 fine
- (3) Fourth and subsequent offenses – \$750.00 fine

Each day that a violation occurs or is permitted to exist constitutes a repeat offense.
